FLORIDA STRONG FAMILIES TAX CREDIT PROGRAM

The Strong Families Tax Credit allows Florida businesses to receive 100% tax credits for donations made to approved nonprofits like Operation Healing Forces—helping America's wounded, ill, injured, and fallen Special Operations Forces (SOF) service members and their families.

Any business that pays one or more of the following Florida state taxes can participate:

- Corporate Income Tax
- Insurance Premium Tax
- Alcoholic Beverage Excise Tax
- Oil & Gas Production Tax
- Use Tax (under a direct pay permit)

Select "Strong Families Tax Credit"
Complete and submit your application
Wait for approval (usually a few days). You must be approved before donating!

MAKE YOUR DONATION

After receiving your tax credit approval, submit your contribution to **OperationHealingForces**

RECEIVE YOUR CERTIFICATE

You'll receive your **Certificate of Contribution** showing your donation was made. Your tax credit is not final until you receive this certificate.

Instructions for Corporations to Claim the Tax Credit Benefiting Operation Healing Forces

Support America's wounded, ill, injured, and fallen Special Operations Forces (SOF) service members and their families by donating to Operation Healing Forces—and receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit in return.

What You'll Need to Apply:

- Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN)
- Business address and contact information
- The amount and type of tax liability you wish to offset with your donation to Operation Healing Forces.

Note: You do not need to donate immediately. However, available credits are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis and are typically claimed within minutes or hours, not days or weeks.

- If filing a Florida corporate income/franchise tax return on a consolidated basis, you'll need the name and FEIN of the parent company.
- The application must be submitted by a corporate officer, owner, or partner.

Step-by-Step Application Instructions:

1. Visit the [Multi-Tax Credits Application](#) on the Florida Department of Revenue website.
2. If you already have an account, click “**Login**”, enter your credentials, and skip to Step 4.
3. If you do not have an account, click “**Create User Profile**” and fill out the form with your username, email address, and password. You'll receive a confirmation email. Click the link in that email to verify your registration, and then log in using the credentials you created.
4. Once logged in, follow the prompts to submit your application for the Strong Families Tax Credit and designate Operation Healing Forces as your chosen nonprofit.

After Submitting Your Application

1. Return to your dashboard to monitor the approval status.
2. Once your credit allocation is approved by the Florida Department of Revenue, notify **Operation Healing Forces** by emailing desiree.holley@ophf.org with the following details:
 - Business Name
 - Amount Approved
 - Allocation Type (e.g., Corporate Income Tax, Insurance Premium Tax)

Next Step: Make Your Donation to Operation Healing Forces

Once your donation is received, Operation Healing Forces (the designated processing partner) will issue a **Certificate of Contribution** reflecting the date and amount of your contribution. This certificate enables you to claim your tax credit.
